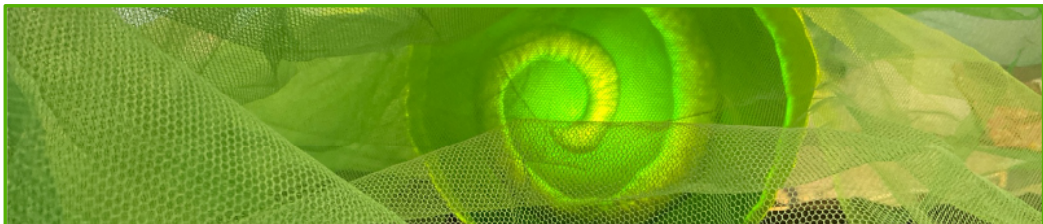


Enjoying Your Time in and around Ōtepoti (Dunedin)
